Key Findings & Tips

The Pug Rescue Landscape

After reviewing rescue organizations across all 50 states, here's what we discovered:

M By the Numbers:

- 47 pug-specific rescue organizations actively operating across the United States
- 13 multi-breed rescues that specifically include pugs in their mission
- 37 states have dedicated pug rescues within their borders
- 13 states rely on neighboring state rescues for pug-specific help

Important Patterns We Found

Most rescues are foster-based: The vast majority operate through networks of volunteer foster homes rather than maintaining physical shelter facilities. This means they can provide more personalized care for each pug!

****Brachycephalic breed rescues are your friends**: Organizations focusing on flat-faced breeds (like French Bulldogs, Boston Terriers, and English Bulldogs) often include pugs because these breeds share similar health considerations and care requirements.

No pug left behind: Almost every rescue we found operates with a policy of accepting any pug regardless of age, health condition, or behavioral issues. Many provide hospice care for pugs too sick or old to be adopted.

Tips for Working with Pug Rescues

If you're looking to adopt:

- Be patient! Most rescues have thorough application processes including home visits
- Consider adopting a senior pug they make wonderful companions
- Be prepared for adoption fees ranging from \$100-\$800 depending on age and location

If you need to surrender a pug:

- Contact rescues early many have waiting lists
- Be honest about any medical or behavioral issues
- Most rescues will take any pug, but some are at capacity for intake

If you want to help:

- Foster homes are always needed
- Donations go primarily to medical care (often 90%+ of budgets)
- Transport volunteers help move pugs between states
- Social media sharing helps find homes

Regional Coverage Notes

Best Coverage: California, Texas, and the Northeast have the most pug rescue options

Limited Coverage: Alaska, Hawaii, Montana, North Dakota, and Nevada have no pug-specific rescues but are served by general animal shelters
